

# This book is...

What I believe sets the direction for my life, it determines what I stand for, what my purpose is in life, my reason for being, what I live for and what I would die for. I believe the Word of God.

The Bible is the written Word of God. It is not an ordinary book, it is alive. 2 Timothy 3:16-17 says, "All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work". The words that were written in the Bible were given to the writers by the Holy Spirit, and the words themselves are living words. Hebrews 4:12 says, "The Word of God is living and active..." The Bible is a work of the Holy Spirit, and the Holy Spirit works in those who read it, and as they apply it to their life.

An unknown writer wrote, "This Book is the mind of God, the state of man, the way of salvation, the doom of sinners, and the happiness of believers. Its doctrines are holy, its precepts are binding; its histories are true, and its decisions are immutable. Read it to be wise, believe it to be safe, practice it to be holy. It contains light to direct you, food to support you, and comfort to cheer you. It is the traveler's map, the pilgrim's staff, the pilot's compass, the soldier's sword, and the Christian's character. Here paradise is restored, heaven opened, and the gates of hell disclosed. Christ is its grand subject, our good its design, and the glory of God its end. It should fill the memory, rule the heart, and guide the feet. Read it slowly, frequently, prayerfully. It is a mine of wealth, a paradise of glory, and a river of pleasure. Follow its precepts and it will lead you to Calvary, to the empty tomb, to a resurrected life in Christ; yes, to glory itself, for eternity."
