2. Or... write down:

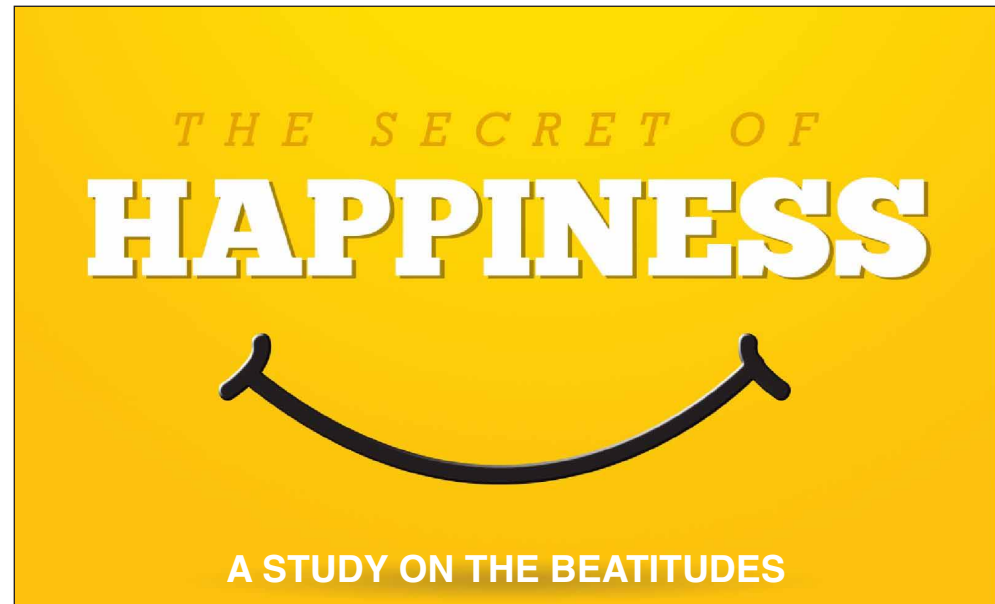
- a. My life before I became a Christian

4. Read Colossians 1:19-20. What does the word 'reconcile' mean?

6. Read 1 John 1:9; Philippians 3:13-14, 4:6-7. Many people know that they have been forgiven, but continue to live with the remorse and regret of things in the past. What do these verses say about that?

7. Read John 14:27, 16:33. Just before Jesus was crucified He told His disciples that He was going to be crucified. No doubt, they were troubled, and struggling with what He had told them. However, Jesus said, "do not let your heart be troubled". What was the basis for them not being troubled? How does this apply to us when we are facing difficult circumstances?

8. Read Romans 12:18. What does 'inasmuch as it depends upon you' mean?
