1. We read this at the beginning of this series, but read again Matthew 28:19-20. What is the call of God on our lives?

Does the great commission apply to all Christians?

2. Read Romans 12:1-2. Some things that are in God's will we don't have to discern - they are written in the Bible. From these two verses, what is the process of coming to know the will of God, when it's not totally obvious?

How do we apply this to our lives?

3. Read Acts 16:6-10. Paul is on his second missionary journey. He already knew God's will to preach the Gospel, but needed direction. What was the process that led him to end up in Macedonia?

In what way do you think the "Spirit of Jesus" led him?

4. When we are wanting to tell others about Jesus, praying for God to open a 'door of opportunity' is a very effective way. It prepares the way for us, and we know that God is preparing the hearts of those who need to hear - just like when God sent Paul to Macedonia. How can you pray this way for those God wants you to reach?

4. In the sermon, Peter said, 'Wherever God has placed you is where God wants to use you.' In what ways do you think God can use you for the furtherance of His kingdom?

5. Read Acts 17:1-4. This passage says that Paul explained, and proved, from the Scriptures, that Jesus had to suffer and rise from the dead. How well do you know the Bible? Could you to tell someone else, "from the Bible", what it means to put their trust in Jesus as Saviour?
