

5. Read Acts 2:41-47. What do you see in these verses that you think contributed to the church's spiritual health & growth? What might be missing from the church today?

7. What is your response to the Vision of Emmanuel in relation to spiritual growth?

8. How do you need apply this message to your life? What is an action step you can take?
