- 1. Read Acts 11:19-24
 Grace is the, "Undeserved favour of God." What does that mean?
- Grace is also, "The empowering presence of God." What does that mean?
- So putting those two definitions together, what did Barnabus see when he arrived in Antioch?
- 2. From this passage, Peter gave eight things that were noticeable in the church at Antioch. Of these (opposite) which one spoke to you most, and why?
- 3. Verse 20 begins, "Some of them..." These people were unnamed people who were telling others about Jesus. Who are some of the people who have influenced your spiritual journey?
- 4. What is significant about the fact that they were telling 'Greeks?' Note that in Galatians 2, it talks about Jews and Gentiles sitting down together, in Antioch, to share meals. (Also read John 13:35). How does this apply to us?
- 5. In verse 21 it says that the Lord's hand was with them and a great number of people believed. There was significant growth in the church in Antioch, and the whole passage gives a picture of a church where people were involved in each others lives. Since we are living in a culture that is becoming increasingly 'insular', how important is it that we are there for each other? Explain.
- 6. Verse 21 says, "the Lord's hand was with them and a great number of people believed and turned to the Lord." If we turn to the Lord, it means that we are turning away from something else. What is it that we are turning away from? Are there some things that you need to turn away from?
- 7. Verse 23 says, "When he arrived and saw the evidence of the grace of God, he was glad and encouraged them all to remain true to the Lord with all their hearts." The fact that Barnabus has to encourage them to remain true, indicates that being faithful isn't always easy. There are a lot of pressures that try to turn us away from God. What are some of those pressures in your life, and what can you do to make sure that you 'remain true to the Lord?'
