
## Psalm 84

- 1. Have you ever thought of your life as a pilgrimage? How does living as a pilgrim change your view of life?
- 2. There are 4 aspects (from this Psalm) of living as a pilgrim (see notes opposite). Review each one, and answer the question How do I live this way?
- 3. Read Mark 15:1-25. Simon and his family were on a pilgrimage to celebrate Passover in Jerusalem. It was probably the trip of a lifetime. Try to put yourselves in his position as the soldier orders you to pick up the cross. What would be going through your head? What about his wife and children watching how do you think they are feeling?
- 4. We go on a pilgrimage to bring ourselves into the presence of God. Simon literally looked into the face of God as he picked up the cross. Read Luke 9:23. What should be our goal in life as a pilgrim?
- 5. Our pilgrimage takes us through the valley of Baka the valley of tears. We all go through times of grief, hardship and struggle, that often bring us to tears. The NLT translates Psalm 84:6-7, "As they pass through the Valley of Baka, they make it a place of springs; the autumn rains also cover it with pools. They go from strength to strength, till each appears before God in Zion." What does this say about the life of the pilgrim who is going through the valley of tears?
- 6. Psalm 84 finishes with, "blessed is the one who trusts in you." (v.12) Jesus talks to His disciples about the destination of our pilgrimage in John 14:1-6. His disciples were greatly troubled and filled with grief because Jesus had told them he was going to die. Jesus gave them an assurance. What was it? Verse 5 says, "Blessed are those whose strength is in you, whose hearts are set on pilgrimage." How do we set out heart on pilgrimage? (Read Ps 84:10-12)
