Small Group Questions (John 6:16-59)

Q1. Have you ever done something wrong that you had to pay for or work to make right?

Q2. The people asked Jesus what they must do to complete the works that God requires (verse 28). How does Jesus answer?

Q3. Some have described this as unfair because it demands too little of us. Do you agree?

Q4. The people had followed Jesus to the feeding of the 5,000 because of the healings he had done. So, they had seen healings, the feeding of the 5,000 and heard power teachings. But they still wanted a sign to prove who he said he was. Can you relate to this? Sometimes I (Dan) feel like I am needy and want God to prove himself to me all the time!

Q5. Read Matthew 16:1-4. Jesus seems to get frustrated when people ask for a sign. However, Philip asked him to “show us the father” and Jesus was gracious (John 14:8). Gideon asked God for multiple signs and God was gracious and answered his prayer (Judges 6). **Why do you think that God is annoyed by some of the people asking but is gracious with others?**

Q6. The people were asking what they needed to *do* in order to accomplish the works that God wanted from them. Why might someone choose to “work” for their salvation in their own strength instead of accepting Jesus’ free gift?

Q7. Read the account of Jesus on the road to Emmaus—especially Luke 24:25-27. The Old Testament pointed to Jesus. The manna in the wilderness is an example of this. When you read the OT do you look for Jesus?

Q8. Can you think of any other things in the Old Testament that point towards Jesus? (ex: the Passover lamb).
