1. Read John 5:1-14. This is the background to the passage we are studying this week. The religious leaders were critical of Jesus healing this man on the sabbath. In verse 12, they asked the man who had been healed, “Who is this fellow who told you to pick it up and walk?” How would you describe Jesus to someone who didn’t know Him?

2. Read John 5:16-18. The Pharisees, and other Jewish leaders, understood from what Jesus said, that He was making Himself equal with God. Why is it important to the Christian faith to understand that Jesus is God in the flesh?

3. Read Ephesians 1:7 and Hebrews 9:28. These are just a couple of the many verses and passages in the Bible that talk about what Jesus accomplished by going to the cross. What are the essentials about Jesus life and ministry?

4. Read John 5:19-21. Jesus said that He only does what He sees His Father doing. What is significant about this in understanding the life and ministry of Jesus? What does this teach us about how we should be living our lives?

5. Read John 5:22-24. As the Son of God, the father has entrusted judgement to the Son. One day we will stand before the judgement seat of Christ. From verse 24, what does it mean to, ‘whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life?’

What does the statement, ‘has crossed over from death to life,’ mean?

6. Read John 5:28-30. What does this passage say about the judgement to come?

7. Read John 5:31-35. This is the first of the testimonies that Jesus refers to about who He is. Here, Jesus is referring to John the Baptist. Why was John’s testimony so important?

In what way should our life reflect the purpose of John the Baptist’s life?

8. Read John 5:36. How do these works testify that the Father sent the Son (Also see John 3:1-2).

Read John 14:12. What does Jesus mean by this statement. How can we do ‘greater things?’ How can our works point others to God?
