

- 2. Read Philippians 4:6-7 and James 1:5. What does these two verses tell us that God will give us in the midst of our troubling situations? Have you seen this to be the case in your own life?
- 3. Read Daniel 2:1-13. What do you think of King Nebuchadnezzar's demands? Why do you think he reacted this way?
- 4. Nebuchadnezzar, and the people of Babylon, understood that there is a spiritual dimension to life. They wouldn't have had magicians, enchanters, sorcerers and astrologers being so prominent in the affairs of state if they didn't. However these men were calling on demonic powers, spiritual forces of evil, for their wisdom. How aware are you of spiritual warfare? Read 1 Peter 5:8 and Ephesians 6:10-13.

If you have ever been involved in seances, occult, ouija boards, crystals etc. then you will have opened yourself up to demonic influences. You need to confess it, denounce it and get rid of anything that you still have, that links you to it.
