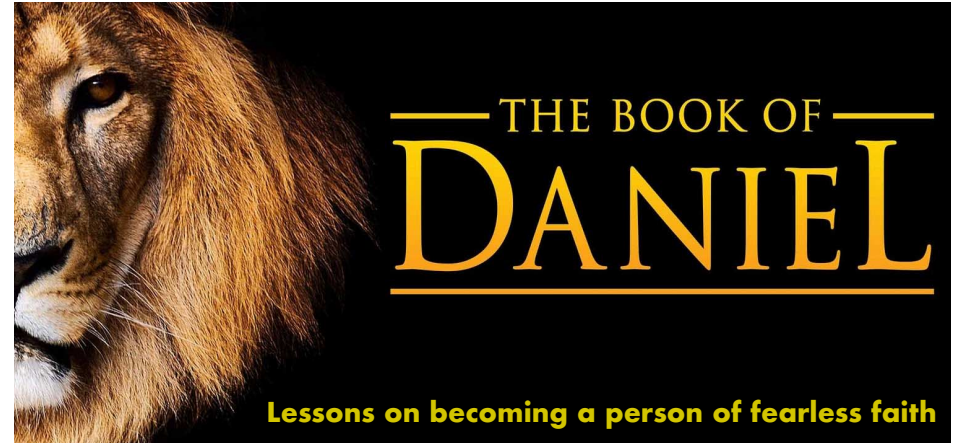
- Pray for all of the Children and Youths heading back to school to find joy and purpose in life.

7. In verse 16 we see that Daniel prayed in faith - he was trusting God to give him the answer he needed. Praying in faith doesn't mean that we will necessarily get what we think we want, or need. So what does it mean?
8. Daniel also prayed in humility. He asked his friends for help, recognising that he couldn't do this on his own. How important do you think this is?
9. Finally, Daniel prayed through. What does that mean, and how do we do it?
10. Read Daniel 2:20-23. Pick out something from this prayer of praise, that touches your heart and life. Explain.

Why do you think thanksgiving is so important?

11. Read Daniel 2:24-28. Daniel went to the king. Verse 28 begins, "...but there is a God in heaven..." We need to prepare ourselves for when we find ourselves in difficult and troubling situations in the future. What can we do to become people who live in an attitude of prayer, like Daniel?

2. Read Philippians 4:6-7 and James 1:5. What does these two verses tell us that God will give us in the midst of our troubling situations?

3. Read Daniel 2:1-13. What do you think of King Nebuchadnezzar's demands? Why do you think he reacted this way?

4. Nebuchadnezzar, and the people of Babylon, understood that there is a spiritual dimension to life. They wouldn't have had magicians, enchanters, sorcerers and astrologers being so prominent in the affairs of state if they didn't. However these men were calling on demonic powers, spiritual forces of evil, for their wisdom. How aware are you of spiritual warfare? Read 1 Peter 5:8 and Ephesians 6:10-13.

If you have ever been involved in seances, occult, ouija boards, crystals etc. then you will have opened yourself up to demonic influences. You need to confess it, denounce it and get rid of anything that you still have, that links you to it.

5. Read Daniel 2:14-19. We are told that Daniel spoke to Arioch with wisdom and tact. He also went to see the king, and was given some time to interpret the dream. What was the difference between Daniel and the other royal advisors, in the way they responded to this very difficult and troubling situation?

In what way had Daniel already prepared himself to handle such situations?

6. Read Daniel 6:10. What was Daniel's routine for prayer?

Now read Philippians 4:6-7. Daniel's life was lived in an attitude of prayer. How can we live that way. What difference do you think it could make?
