

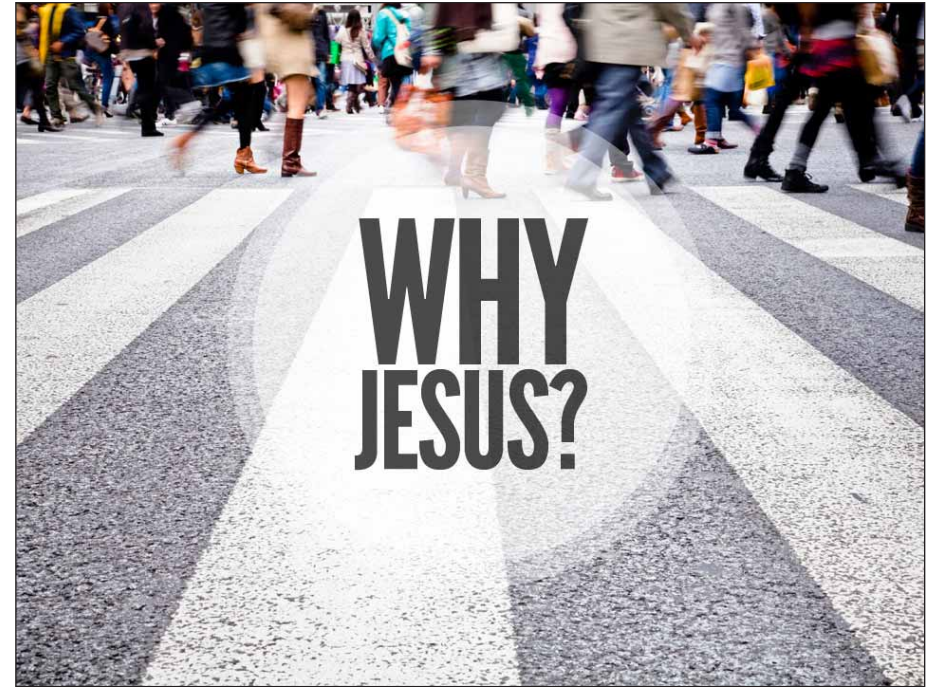
EMMANUEL PRAYER LIST

4. Read Colossians 1:15-20. List the things that this passage says about Jesus. What stands out to you the most? Why?

5. Read John 1:1-4 and John 1:14. Explain what these two verses mean.

6. Read Hebrews 4:15. As a human being, Jesus had a human body, he got tired and hungry, had human emotions, like feeling sad, loving people etc. He was also tempted. How significant is all this to us. Why is it important that He was fully God and fully human?
