
Haiti

2 Timothy 3:16

_____ Scripture is God breathed and is useful for...

- 1. The Bible is the final authority in all matters of faith and life. What does this mean and why?
- 2. Read Romans 10:17. Why and how does faith 'come' to us? Why is it that the Word of God is central to faith coming to us?
- 3. Luke 5:1-11. In verses 1-2 we see Simon Peter busy cleaning his nets, and listening to Jesus. What do you think was Peter's level of interest at this point?
- 4. In verse 3 Jesus got into Peter's boat to continue teaching the people. All of a sudden Simon Peter has no choice but to listen intently to Jesus. Can you remember a time when Jesus stepped into your life and his message became more personal?
- 5. After finishing teaching the people, Jesus told Peter to put the boat out to catch fish. This didn't make sense to Peter. What do you think was going on inside Peter, for him to say, "but because you say so, I will let down the nets."

How does the Word of God speak to our hearts and get out attention, to the point that we realise that we need to do what it says?

- 6. After the great catch of fish, Peter calls Jesus Lord rather than just, 'master' (see verses 5 and 8). Why do you think this happened?
- 7. Simon Peter acknowledge that he was a sinful man. Being in the presence of Jesus can do that to a person. Why do you think Peter said, 'get away from me Lord?'
- 8. Read verse 11. Simon Peter has gone from casually listening to Jesus, while at the same time cleaning his fishing nets, to leaving everything and following Jesus. Go through the events in this passage of scripture that led Simon Peter to make this drastic change in His life.

9. Read 2 timothy 3:16-17. What does it mean that all scripture is 'God breathed?'
